For this we are deeply sorry and would like to attempt to correct that error with this memorial tribute to our friend and neighbor, Bob Pease.



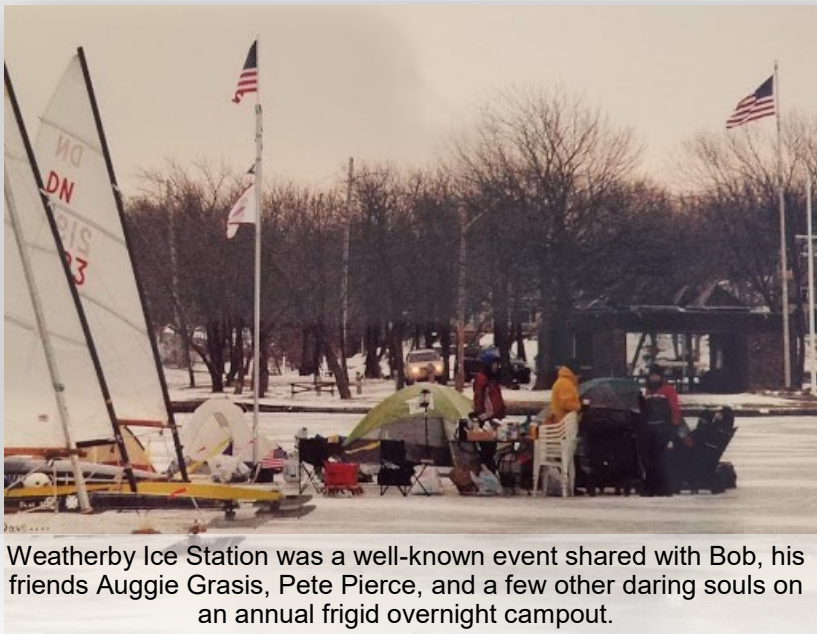
ROBERT GLENN PEASE
