We are pleased to report that the Spring distribution of BackSnacks, is 2,580! In the past five years, Feed Northland Kids, has funded the expansion of Harvesters BackSnack program from 1,000 children in 29 Clay and Platte County schools, to 2,580 children in 59 schools! An Independent evaluation confirmed 18% of children participating in the BackSnack program showed improved grades in english, social studies and science. Schools report discipline incidents are cut in half and 34% of parents say their child's health has improved since participating in the program.
